691	On site of First and Second Temples in Jerusalem, Dome of the Rock built	
1099-1291	Crusader Domination (Latin Kingdom of Jerusalem)	
1291-1516	Mamluk Rule	
1517-1917	Ottoman Rule	
1564	Code of Jewish law (Shulhan Arukh) published	
1860	First neighborhood (Mishkenot Sha'ananim) built outside Jerusalem's walls	
1882-1903	First large-scale immigration mainly from Russia	
1904-1914	Second large-scale immigration mainly from Russia and Poland	
1909	First Kibbutz (Degania) and first modern all-Jewish city (Tel Aviv) founded	
1918-1948	British Rule
